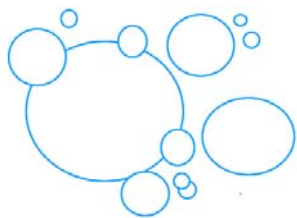


Fundraising Event

Anyone organizing a **Car Wash Event** is directed to borrow the Free Car Wash Kit available through the ***West Valley Clean Water Program (WVCWP)***

The *State Water Board* requires municipalities to prevent Car Wash Event runoff from flowing into Storm Drains.

(Enforced by Municipal Codes)



All Car Wash Events should use the ***Car Wash Kit***, which keeps runoff out of Storm Drains.

- Copper is toxic to aquatic life - It washes off of brake pads
- Oil, coolant & other pollutants are also carried in car wash runoff
- The Car Wash Kit drains runoff into the Sanitary Sewer lines, rather than into the Storm Drains (which flow untreated into our creeks)
